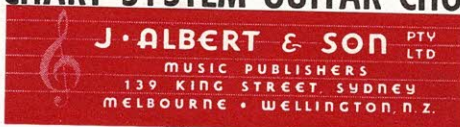

Foreword

This work is not just another catalog of chords. The system employed here, is to present the chords in the keys to which they belong. Both the major and relative minor keys are illustrated.

Each key has three primary or fundamental chords, which form the basic harmony of all songs. These keys and their respective chords should be memorized. Once learned, you can literally play hundreds of songs in the keys suitable for your singing voice.

Large size chord charts are used, with the left hand fingering plainly indicated for quick orientation.

We have also touched lightly on the subject of "Movable Chords", to give you an insight into their workings. Also, the device called the "Capo" and how to use it.
