Grow Your Guitar Skills

What's next once you have basic guitar strum skills? Progress your basic technique with lead-ups, walk downs, chord progressions, dynamics. These techniques will enhance your playing. It's a slow session, bring your guitar and Dominic will show you how to get more out of it.

Blues Harmonica Workshop

Take the first steps in learning blues style harmonica with Bill Buttler. Learn basic chords, the 12 bar blues progression, bending notes, making train sounds etc. Bring a standard 10 hole diatonic harmonica in C. For those with some knowledge, as well as beginners. Notes supplied.

Squeezebox Mysteries Explained

The button box is light, portable and big on sound. It and the harmonica work pretty much the same way, so knowing one is a great start with the other. Bring a 10 hole harmonica in C if you don't have a squeezebox. Notes supplied.

Rounds are a lovely way to gain confidence in singing 'against' someone else. We'll try some simple exercises to help get your ear in sync with other singers. Expect to be moving around occasionally while singing. Ken will lead.
